



TOWN OF WILLOW BUNCH  
BYLAW NO. 163/91

A Bylaw of the Town of Willow Bunch, in the Province of Saskatchewan, Canada, regarding the use of vacant Town lots and improvements.



The Council of the Town of Willow Bunch, Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:
  - (a) "LOTS" means vacant lots owned by the Town of Willow Bunch and located within the Town limits.
  - (b) "PERMIT" means written authority of the Town Administrator.
2. No person, corporation, or organization shall use or occupy in any manner whatsoever any lots owned by the Town of Willow Bunch without first obtaining a written permit authorizing such use or occupancy.
3. Permits shall be issued at the discretion of the Town of Willow Bunch to enable access to and/or use of such lots for times as specified in the permit, and for the purposes specified in the permit.
4. Any breach of this Bylaw or use of lots without a permit or for purposes other than specified in the permit shall be an infraction punishable pursuant to the penalties provided for in the general penalty Bylaw of the Town of Willow Bunch, being Bylaw No.140.
5. The Bylaw comes into force on the date this Bylaw is passed, which is December 10, 1991.
