BYLAW NO. 224/10

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE OPERATION OF ATV'S UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND BACK ALLYS AND OTHER AREAS WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW BUNCH

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW BUNCH, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. This bylaw shall be known and may be cited as "The ATV Bylaw".
2. In this bylaw, including this section:
 - (a) "all terrain vehicle" and/or "ATV" means three or more wheel ATV's
3. It shall be lawful to operate an ATV on any traveled portion of a street or back ally within the corporate limits of the Town of Willow Bunch
4. No person shall operate an ATV:
 - (a) on any other public land that is not a street or back alley, whether or not marked by a sign
 - (b) Outside the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
5. Notwithstanding Subsection 4(b) it shall be lawful to operate a ATV on a street or back alley during an emergency when all other vehicular traffic is unable to travel on said street or alley due to snow or weather conditions.
6. The All-Terrain Vehicles Act and the Highway Traffic Act supersedes all provisions of this bylaw.
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its date of adoption.

All Terrain Vehicles Act

- “All terrain vehicle”** (b) “all terrain vehicle” means a self-propelled vehicle that:
- (i) is designed primarily for the movement of people or goods on unprepared surfaces; and
 - (ii) has wheels in contact with the ground;

and includes:

- (iii) a restricted use motorcycle
- (iv) a mini-bike and
- (v) an all terrain cycle;

but does not include:

- (vi) a golf cart;
- (vii) a snowmobile as defined in *The Snowmobile Act*;
- (viii) an agricultural implement or special mobile machine as defined in *The Traffic Safety Act*; or
- (ix) any vehicle that is required to be registered pursuant to *The Traffic Safety Act*;

- “Crown land”** (d) “Crown land” means any land, other than a highway owned By Her Majesty the Queen in right of Saskatchewan;

- “Private land”** (p) “Private land” means land other than public land;

- “Public land”** (r) “Public land” means Crown land or any land vested in a municipality.

Traffic Safety Act

- “Vehicle”** (ccc) “vehicle” means a devise in, on or by which a person or thing is or may be transported or drawn on a highway and includes special mobile machines and agricultural implements but does not include vehicles running only on rails or solely on railway company property;
