

BYLAW NO. 3/2016

A BYLAW TO ASSESS AND LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION, SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES.

The Council of the Town of Willow Bunch in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:

- (a) "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Willow Bunch.
- (b) "Service Provider" shall mean the Town of Willow Bunch and the RM of Willow Bunch No. 42 Volunteer Fire Department who has been engaged by the Municipality to provide the fire prevention suppression or other emergency response service.

2. Fire Response shall mean any response by:

- (a) The Town of Willow Bunch & RM of Willow Bunch No. 42 Volunteer Fire Department.

3. The owner/recipient for whom any fire response is provided shall be responsible for the payment of a "fee for service" for each and every fire response as follows :

- (a) Town of Willow Bunch and RM of Willow Bunch #42 fire response -the hourly fire response call out fees set by the RM of Willow Bunch and the Town of Willow Bunch as stated in Exhibit "A".
- (b) The costs of chemicals and other extinguishing agents, excluding water, used to extinguish or prevent and/or limit the spread of fire.

4. The Town of Willow Bunch (who administers the joint RM and Town fire department) will add or request to add that the RM or Town councils add to the taxes any unpaid fire charges at December 31st.

5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its date of adoption.

6. The Town of Willow Bunch has set a cap of \$10,000 per fire to be invoiced to the ratepayer .
