Fielded calls from Willow Bunch ratepayers regarding noxious weeds, shoulder pulling, gravel and website communications or lack thereof.


Investigated contaminated soil dumped at RM yard (no permission)

Followed up on status of grant application to Western Economic Diversification regarding JLLRP water and sewer project.


Received a call from RM 43 regarding disaster relief.
