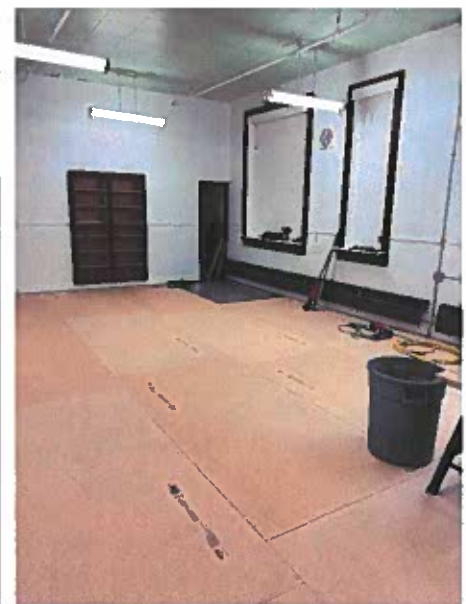

WHAT AN AWESOME JOB THEY HAVE DONE THE ROOM LOOKS GREAT!!!

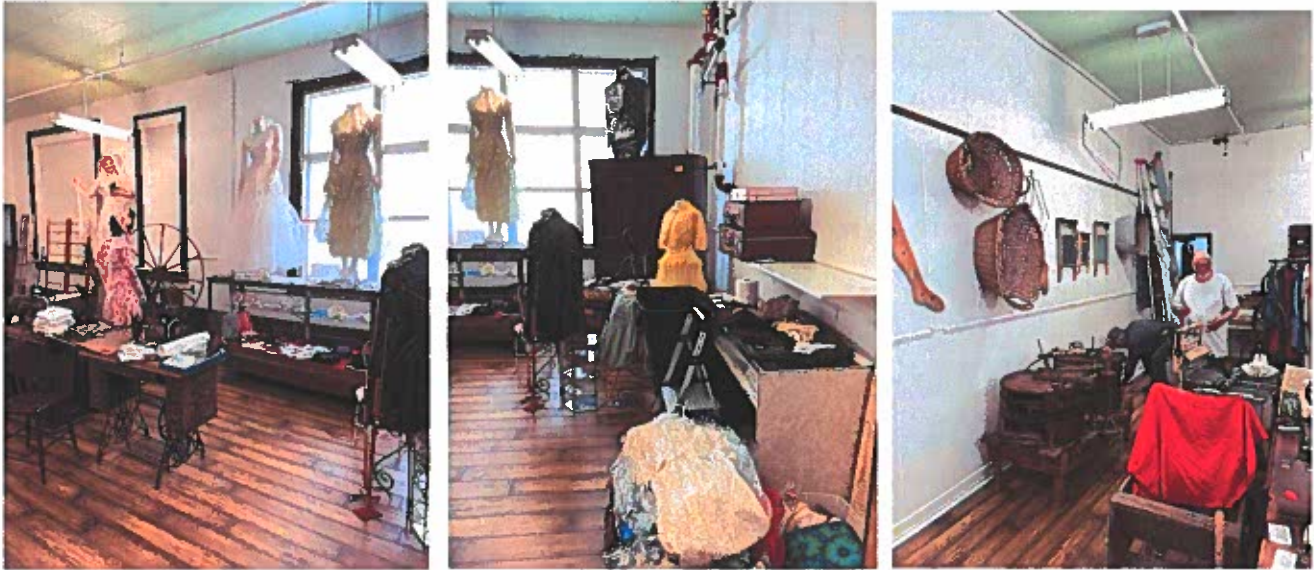

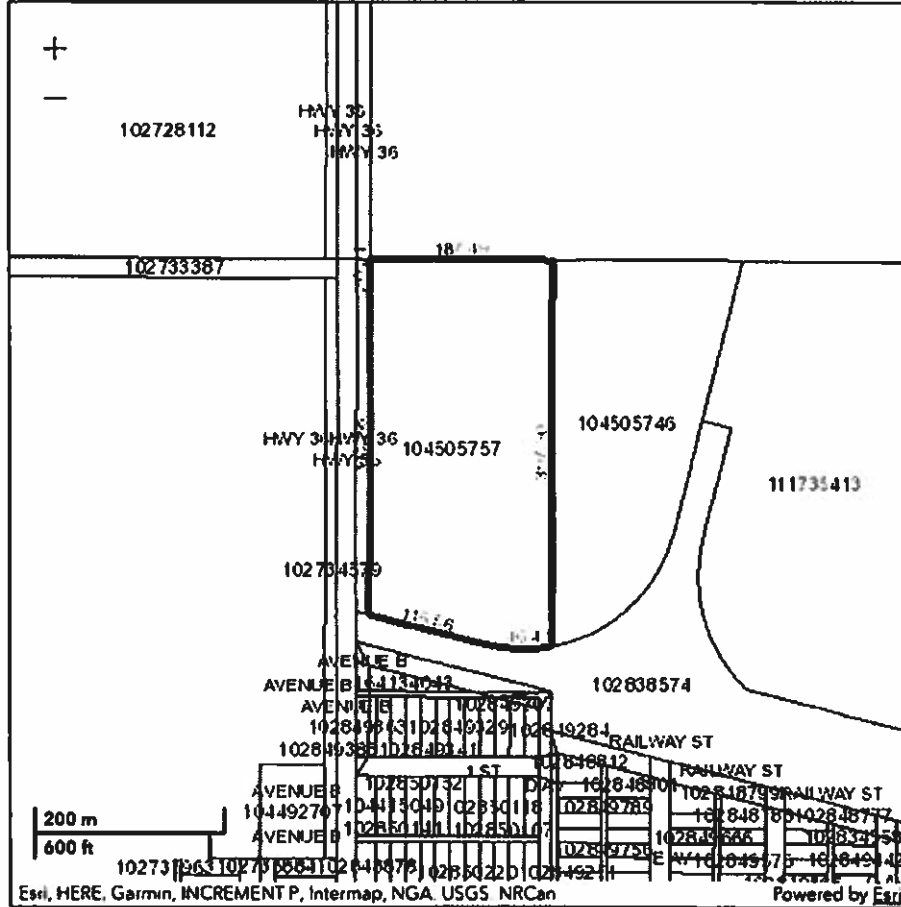

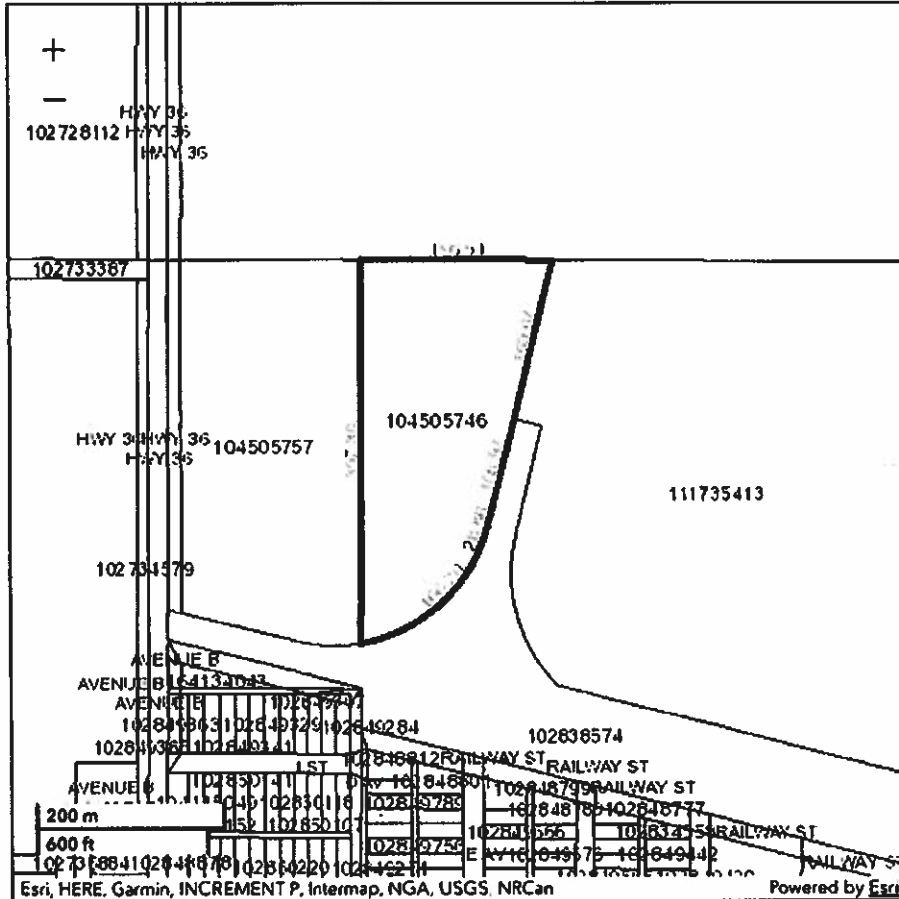
